



## OSHA'S TOP 10 MOST CITED VIOLATIONS (2017)

OSHA recently came out with their annual top 10 violations list. Two of the ten violations were directly related to fall protection; including specific violations related to fall protection training. The list is as follows:

- 1) 1926.501- *Fall Protection - General Requirements*
- 2) 1910.1200 - *Hazard Communication*
- 3) 1926.451- *Scaffolding*
- 4) 1910.134 - *Respiratory Protection*
- 5) 1910.147- *Lockout/Tagout*
- 6) 1926.1053 - *Ladders*
- 7) 1910.178 - *Powered Industrial Trucks*
- 8) 1910.212- *Machine Guarding*
- 9) 1926.503 - *Fall protection—Training Requirements*
- 10) 1910.305 - *Electrical—Wiring Methods*
