



OSHA Delays Electronic Reporting

July 1, 2017 Deadline Delayed

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) is proposing to delay the deadline for electronic reporting. The original deadline of July 1, 2017 appears to no longer be the effective reporting date. As of the date of this SafeALERT, OSHA has not provided a new deadline.

While this likely comes as a relief to many employers, you should remain vigilant in monitoring the ruling; however, it appears that employers can rest easy for now.
